# Day Treatment & ITS Classrooms Reopen



After closing along with schools across our community in response to the COVID-19 threat, we're glad to be able to move forward with re-opening two of our classrooms serving our Day Treatment and Intensive High School Treatment program. As part of our continued efforts to keep our clients and staff safe, we have scaled back classroom numbers, have a supply of masks for staff and students to wear on campus, have rearranged our on-campus classroom spaces to allow for socially distanced learning, further increased our sanitation procedures, and have a new daily check-in procedure before the start of class where all students and staff will be screened for fever or other COVID-19 symptoms.

We want to thank everyone, from our clients, to the those in the community who supported us, and of course our dedicated staff, for their patience and support during this unprecedented time. As we continue to move forward in the phases of re-opening, we hope to continue welcoming back more students to our programs in a safe, healthy, and compassionate manner.
